Roman Huber has served as Managing Director of the State of Bavaria's venture capital company Bayern Kapital GmbH since 2006. As a wholly owned subsidiary of LfA Förderbank Bayern, Bayern Kapital funds seed, start-up and later stage financing for innovative Bavarian companies.

Born in Munich in 1958, Roman Huber received his training as a banker at the Hypo-Bank in Munich and then completed his studies in business administration at LMU in Munich in 1986. From 1986 to 2005, he worked at LfA Förderbank Bayern in the innovation financing division, serving as its head starting in 1992. As part of this job, Huber was responsible for the economic assessment of research and development projects in private companies. This type of assessment is required within the framework of Bavarian technology funding programs, loan financing from LfA in the area of innovation, and investment inquiries made to LfA investment subsidiaries.
